BIKEABILITY LEVEL 2 TRAINING COURSE 20 – 24 FEBRUARY 2012

In March 2007 a new national standard for cycle training called Bikeability was introduced. Bikeability is the Cycling Proficiency Test for the 21st century, designed to give the next generation the skills and confidence to ride their bikes on today's roads. Level 2 training is offered to children aged 10-11 years old (in year 6). More details about Bikeability can be found at www.bikeability.org.uk

This course is being sponsored by Claremont Fan Court Foundation Ltd and has been booked for the week of 20-24 February 2012. It will be led and supervised by trained Bikeability staff. We expect children to behave responsibly and courteously throughout the course. The course will run during the school day on suitable roads in and around the local area to the school.

In order to participate, your child must bring to school a bicycle that is in a roadworthy condition and also have a properly fitting cycle helmet. Bicycles can be left at school during this week.

Unfortunately, there are only a limited number of spaces available on the course and so applications to take part will be treated on a first come first served basis. You will, of course, be informed if your application to take part has been successful.
